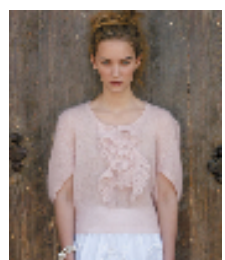

Beginners Knitting courses: Saturday 6th February 2010 10am-12.30pm For all of you with a wish to learn to knit as your New Years Resolution. All you need to get started, casting on, basic knit and purl stitches and casting off. Taught by Gillian Fulton. Yarn and Needles provided. £20 Refreshments and light lunch provided.

Beginners Crochet Saturday 13th February 2010 with Jackie Carreira.

This is aimed at the absolute beginner or those in need of refreshing! Starting with the basics such as Foundation chains, Double Crochet & Treble Crochet and tips on holding the hook and yarn. 10am – 1pm including lunch and refreshments. £25.

Knitting Felted Items: Saturday 20th February 2010 2pm-5pm create felted pin cushion which can be felted and embellished. Taught by Gillian a 3 hour course including refreshments £25. Please bring your own needles a choice of yarn will be provided for your projects.

Moebius Basket Class: Saturday 20th February 2010. With Gillian Fulton. 10am – 1.30pm including light lunch and refreshments. Using Moebius Cast on method on circular needles you will be taught how to make this gorgeous basket which can then be felted. This is a beautiful technique which looks tricky but is surprisingly easy. £25 including yarn, method creates a seamless piece of knitting and the baskets are worked from the handle downwards. Please bring a pair of 7-8mm circular needles. 100cm in length or purchase here with your 10% class discount. Yarn included in cost of class.



Saturday 27th February 2010: Using circular needles and easy Fair Isle. With Gillian Fulton. Learn how to keep tension correct and stranding yarns across the back of your work and the benefits of knitting on circular needles with this technique to create a beautiful fairisle hat. Suitable for knitters who can follow a pattern. 10am-4pm including light lunch & refreshments £35.

Saturday 6th March 2010: Learning the Art of Entrelac: with Gillian Fulton. Learn the tricks of the trade with this wonderful colour blocking technique and creating a beautiful hot water bottle cover. Yarn for this project is included. Please bring 4.5 or 5mm straight needles. 10 am-2pm light lunch and refreshments provided. £30.

Saturday 13th March: Crocheting Granny Squares and Colour change techniques: 10am-1pm with Jackie Carreira, Moving on from your basic crochet. Learning how to join in colours and creating beautiful squares for a blanket or cushion cover. Please bring a 4mm or 5mm hook. Lunch and refreshments provided. £25.

Saturday 20th March: Knitting and Beading Embellishments: with Gillian Fulton. Pretty and inspiring ideas for adding a personal touch to your garments. Making flowers and other ideas for adding that something special. 10am -2pm light lunch and refreshments included. £25. equipment will be provided.

Saturday 27th March: Easy Cabling techniques: with Gillian Fulton. Never be afraid of Cables again. Gillian will show you how to recognise different cable instructions and techniques to make it all so easy!! And to create a beautiful but simple cabled bag. 10am-2pm £30. Lunch and Yarn included.

Saturday 3rd April: Beginners Knitting: 10am-12.30pm with Gillian Fulton. All you need to get started, casting on, basic knit and purl stitch and casting off. Yarn and Needles included and also a light lunch and refreshments. £20.
